Dear Parents and Caregivers

Thank you once again to the P and C for running the Mother's Day Stall conducted last Friday. This was a very successful activity and provided a wonderful service to the school. The North Parmelia PS P and C has made an incredible contribution to the school over many years. Any support you can provide your P and C, either by direct membership or by supporting their programs, is greatly appreciated and ultimately assists the school and your children. The Mother's Day Stall follows on from the Colour Run held last term. The Colour Run, organised by the P and C was incredibly successful and raised over \$7,000 for the school.

The Crescendo program delivered by the West Australian Symphony Orchestra has been running in the school for nearly 10 years. This is an incredible program that delivers enormous benefit to the education of the students at North Parmelia PS. Benefits derive from specific instruction in music and musical concepts, whilst also assisting with literacy and numeracy instruction, social skills development and engagement. The North Parmelia PS community is incredibly fortunate to be a participant in this program and our thanks go to the West Australian Symphony Orchestra (WASO) for their enormous contribution to our school. WASO are incredibly generous and dedicated to serving the community. This term they have organised a number of events for our students. Earlier this week the older students participated in a creative workshop. Later this term the school will experience a children's opera that retells the classic fairy tale, Rapunzel. The performance will be held at the school on Wednesday 24 May 2023 at 11.15 am. On the 16 June pre-primary to Year 6 students will have the opportunity to travel to the Concert Hall to view a production of Nature's Symphony. We thank WASO for their generous support.

On the 25th May we will celebrate "Walk to School Day." Children and their carers are invited to meet Mr Elsegood and NPPS staff at the Dog Exercise Park on the corner of Parmelia and Sulphur Avenues to commence walking at 8.00 am. A special Breakfast Club will be held as the students' and their supporters arrive at school. This event will also mark the reopening of the refurbished Breakfast Club room.

The 100 Nights Of Reading is continuing and students are now enjoying their rewards for reading for 50 nights. Please encourage your child to participate in this worthwhile activity, so that they can experience the joy of reading.

The school has been participating in the WA PBS program for some years, but progress was slowed during the height of the COVID-19 pandemic. We are now in "full swing" implementing the program. WA PBS focusses on positive strategies to reinforce the school's core values of Friendship, Respect, Excellence and Determination. Students earn reward points for demonstrating appropriate behaviour and are further rewarded with prizes and badges for reaching milestones that demonstrate sustained positive behaviour. Thankyou to Mrs Thomson and her dedicated team who are working hard to implement this program across the school.

Currently the older students are training for the Winter Lightning Carnival to be held on Friday 23 June 2023 at Thomas Oval. Students will participate in Netball, Hockey, Soccer and Football. Training takes place on Friday afternoons. The school cross country is scheduled for Friday 9 June 2023.

Aussie of the Month


The Aussie of the Month award recognises personal endeavour, achievement and contribution to the community.
