SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES – 2025

The School Education Regulations 2000, contains a number of requirements relating to the manner in which contributions and charges are requested from parents. One major requirement is for schools to outline ahead, all contributions and charges that may be incurred by your children throughout the 2025 school year. The North Parmelia Primary School Council has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2025. The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that might be incurred throughout the school year.

1. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

For 2025, the School Council has reviewed our school voluntary contributions. The total amount of contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay for 2025 has been contained within the \$60.00 per student maximum set in the School Education Regulations 2000.

The quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments.

2. CHARGES FOR EXTRA COST OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, in school visits and other activities for 2025 has been included in the schedule provided. Details on charges collected in previous years have been used to help us draw up our 2025 schedule. **Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. As in the past, you will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.** The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the maximum that will be charged for scheduled activities in 2025.

THE CHARGES INCLUDE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH:-

- Activities available to all students, but conditional on payment being made. eg. excursions, in school visits, classroom cooking, interm swimming, etc.
- Specific activities available to selected students, but conditional on payment being made.
eg. Instrumental Music Program, PEAC students, etc.
- Other activities available to students, but conditional on payment being made.
eg. school picnics, graduation, etc.
- Students may be excluded from participation in some activities at the discretion of the school.
- The above charges do not include the cost of school uniforms.

3. ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE

The personal use items will vary from student to student.

They include:

- Stationery items, calculator, etc.
- Pupil requirements recommended but not essential for all students. eg. art shirt, tissues, etc.
- Pupil requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program.
eg. PEAC Course requirements

Your child will need to have the materials listed on their personal items list each school day so it may be necessary to replace some items such as pencils throughout the year.

4. SPELLING MASTERY BOOKS

Spelling Mastery Books will be purchased by the school and payment will be requested at the beginning of the year from parents. ***Spelling Mastery is a compulsory and integral component of the students Literacy Learning Program at North Parmelia Primary.***

5. P & C VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

To assist with P & C Fundraising our P & C requests that parents voluntarily donate \$5.00 per family to the P & C. These funds are used to support the school throughout the year.

This may be paid at the same time as you pay the Voluntary School Contribution at the beginning of the year.
